### Summary: Boraston - Nash Bridleway Loop

A loop from Boraston Church through rolling Shropshire countryside taking in the hamlets of Boraston and Nash.

**Difficulty:** Moderate

**Distance:** 2 miles (3 km)

**Walking time:** 1 hour

**Type:** Circular

**Start location:** Boraston Church WR15 8LH

**What3Words:** ///impressed.oven.decimal

### Route

- 1) Park outside the church
- 2) Walk north-west along the lane to the T-Junction
- 3) Turn north (right) go 100m down the road take left footpath, closing gate behind you. Sheep may be in the field so dogs on leads please.
- 4) Go through gate and over stream using the bridge
- 5) Aim for the lone oak tree and go through the gate
- 6) Continue up hill towards Nash Court Farm walking in the crop tram lines (subject to season)
- 7) Walk through the Nash Court farm yard following footpath signs
- 8) Turn west into the first field and either follow Bridlepath signs or permissive footpath signs.
- 9) The Bridleway takes you back to the T-Junction (2)  
Cross the road and walk back to the church (1)
